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ABOUT PULSS STUDIOS

PULS8 Studios is an established performance studio in Rockhampton. PULS8 Studios students study a diverse range of styles and the associated techniques of each style including ballet, modern jazz, contemporary, lyrical, cabaret, hip hop, tap, musical theatre, cheerleading and singing. Dance students are also eligible to complete examinations under the CSTD Modern Jazz and Tap Syllabus and RAD Classical Ballet Syllabus in 2024.



STUDIO AIMS

At Puls8 Studios, we aim to create a safe and enjoyable learning environment for our students; one that challenges them physically, cognitively and emotionally. We encourage the development of sound technique and skills in every style of performance. It is our goal to create a lifelong love of dance for all our students by encouraging their individual creativity through the provision of personal support, well-rounded training and a high standard of tuition. Our motto is to "Work Hard, Aim High and Dream Big!"

STUDIO LOCATION

Our modern facility is located at 41 Little Musgrave Street in North Rockhampton. The studio is fully air-conditioned. Each studio is equipped with professional sound equipment, ballet bars, acrobatic mats and fitness and Pilates equipment to enhance each student's training.

DANCE STYLES

Students receive training in all the below styles in their performance block classes and as students' progress, the depth of the training increases. Performance packages also include the fees for weekly CSTD Jazz Exam classes, which are compulsory for students undertaking performance work.

- JAZZ Upbeat music and high-energy movements allow students to have fun in an environment that is exciting and enriching
- **BALLET** Ballet classes provide the technical base that is necessary for all styles of dance. The grace and poise taught through ballet technique assists with children's overall confidence, strength and flexibility.
 - **TAP** Tap classes encourage students to develop their musical and rhythmic skills while enjoying a range of musical and performance genres.
- CONTEMPORARY Contemporary classes allow students to learn to express emotions and stories through soft, fluid movement with a focus on strength and flexibility.
 - LYRICAL The lyrical style incorporates the use of emotion with the poise and grace of ballet technique. These classes teach students to express themselves with graceful and delicate movements that convey a uniquely emotive language.

ACROBATICS This class teaches students the gymnastic and tumbling skills that are so heavily incorporated into dance and cheerleading routines.

CHEERLEADING Cheerleading has now developed as a competitive sport, with fast, strong movements choreographed to modern, upbeat music. Cheer classes provide a focus on the strength and flexibility necessary in this physically demanding sport.

MUSICAL These classes encourage students to express themselves by taking **THEATRE** on character roles in a fun and upbeat environment.

SONG & DANCE Incorporating both vocal and dance skills, these classes require students to utilise both skillsets in the same routine in order to entertain audiences.

STRENGTH & Physical and physiological development of athletes for elite sport **CONDITIONING** performance. They also help athletes with injury prevention and proper mechanics within their sports performances.

VOCAL TRAINING Vocal lessons are available for students who wish to refine their vocal techniques. They encourage students to express themselves and really develop their singing abilities.

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UNIFORMS

Students of Puls8 Studios are required to wear the allocated uniform for their classes. We will be introducing some new uniform items this year which will be available from Prima Donna and the studio in Term 1 throughout Term 1. Screen Printing will hopefully be available in early term 1 also.

CLASS FEES AND PAYMENTS

Each Class Fee has an associated cost. PULS8 STUDIOS has an annual levy fee. This will be \$70 per child or \$100 per family if paid before commencement of term. This will need to be paid before the start of Term 1 - no student will be able to commence classes until this fee is paid.

Fees for classes will be issued on a term basis whether in attendance or not.

All overdue fees will incur a \$20 administration fee.

A 2-week trial period will be in place for the beginning of the term should you decide the class is not for you; after this period all term fees must be paid in full by the due date.

Option 1: Payment of term fee in full at commencement of term.

Option 2: An automated direct debit via Pay Choice each fortnight. All paperwork is to be completed and authorised prior to commencement. Please contact our administration staff to arrange this payment option.

If you have committed to our 2024 competition season all costumes will be payable even if all competitive events are not attended.

COSTUMES

Dance costumes are allocated via a hire system – Performance costumes have a one-off hire fee of \$90 - \$120 (plus GST) per costume regardless of how many times it is worn. Prices will vary depending on style (ballet for example will be at the high end of the price range due to lace and labour). Please note, hire fees may be increased subject to the cost of the costumes (E.g., Ballet Tutus).

WORKSHOPS



We try and give the students a variety of dance styles and teaching styles by hosting workshops. These will be most likely be over a weekend each term. There may be associated costs with this depending on fundraising efforts - approx. costings have been listed above. Uniform requirements for workshop have also been listed above under uniforms.

SOLOS

Solos, Duos and Trios are available for performance students who participate in our Elite packages. Please book in an appointment with Caitlin to discuss.

COMPETITION REQUIREMENTS:

- Please make sure you have your jersey and new uniform for competition days. These are compulsory.
- All students will need the JB makeup kit in 2024 (this stops makeup stains on costumes).
- All cheer students will need a glitter kit for competitions. Approx. \$50 for set.
- There may be associated costs to entry fees depending on fundraising efforts.
- We will be incorporating workshop weekends again in 2024. We found these very beneficial and successful last year so we will be implementing these again.

STUDIO AREA GUIDELINES

Warm-up Area

- This area is for students to await their class call noise is to be kept to a minimum as there will be classes in progress. Parents are encouraged to wait outside as some of our waiting areas will be used for classes this year.
- Food and drink are to be consumed outside.
- Class Areas: *No parents are allowed in the studios* only in the case of an emergency or invitation.
- All students are expected to be on time to lessons. We are running to a strict time line to be able to achieve our student outcomes. Therefore, students are expected to be fully prepared prior to commencement of class.
- Students will need to bring bags with shoes, water etc to class.
- Parents please notify the studio if you are going to be late/absent from class via text or email so that these can be recorded.



PULS8 SUPPORTERS ASSOCIATION

Within our Puls8 family, we run fundraising activities to support our families and subsidize some of the costs associated with dance and cheer. The PULS8 Supporters Association, meets per the term.
